

## JAPAN AIRLINES BAGGAGE ON FLIGHT INFORMATION

Each passenger is permitted one piece of carry-on baggage.

A passenger may carry on board one personal belonging, such as a shopping bag or handbag, and one baggage satisfying the conditions below.

Sum of Three Dimensions	Dimensions	Total Weight
Not more than 115cm (45in.)	W55cm×H40cm×D25cm (W22in.×H16in.×D10in.)	10 kg (22 lbs.)

If your baggage is oversized or overweight, or unable to be appropriately stowed in the cabin due to the stowage limitations, it may need to be checked in cargo compartment at the gate.

Premium Economy / Economy class	Piece: <b>2pieces</b> Weight: Each piece must not weigh more than <b>23 kg (50 lbs.)*</b> . Size: The total linear dimensions for each piece of baggage shall not exceed <b>203 cm (80 in.)</b> derived by adding the height, width and length.

### ☐ Inside the Cabin

For your own safety and comfort, please stow your Carry-on baggage under the seat or in the overhead compartments properly.

- ☐ If your baggage is not securely stowed, it may injure yourself or the others in case of turbulence.
- ☐ If your baggage is not securely stowed, it may be scattered in the aisle or emergency exit area and hinder emergency evacuation
- ☐ If you keep your baggage on a lap, it would hinder taking a proper brace position in case of emergency.
- \*If you are seated directly behind screen, emergency exit or cabin separating wall and do not have a seat in front of you, your carry-on baggage may not be placed at your feet.

**Permitted while passenger entry door is open** Electronic devices that emit electronic signals: cell phones, PHS, transceivers, radio-controlled toys, wireless headphones, wireless earphones, wireless microphones, battery powered IC tags, personal computers (PC), personal digital assistants (PDA), electronic game machines, wireless PC peripherals, wireless pedometers, wireless heart rate monitors, wristwatches with wireless functions, wireless keys.

All of the above-mentioned items even in a non-electronic signals-emitting setting, TVs, radios, pagers, GPS receivers, video cameras, video players, DVD players, digital cameras, digital audio equipment, wired & battery type headphones, wired & battery type earphones, word processors, electronic organizers, electronic dictionaries, printers, battery chargers, toys with voice or touch activated speakers and monitors.

- (\*) From the time when seat belt sign is turned off or when the announcement allowing the use of electronic devices is made, to the time announced before landing that the use of electronic devices is prohibited.
- - Company rules restrict the use of electronic devices other than the items mentioned above.
- - Personal computers (PC), personal electronic devices, and electronic game machines must be connected to JAL wireless LAN service to be used during flight.
- - Do not apply strong impacts to any electronic devices containing lithium-ion secondary batteries. (e.g. stepping upon, dropping into gaps of the seat, etc.) This may deform the battery and break the protection circuit built into the battery and cause overheating, explosion or fire.
- - Cabin attendants may ask you to refrain from using electronic devices when there is a passenger who use pacemakers or other medical devices around you.
- - Please be thoughtful of passengers around you when you use the cell phone in cabin.

Kids Phone by NTT Docomo (™SA800i) or Junior Phone by au (A5520SA11/A5525SA/Sweets cute) must be turned off completely as possible in advance as you can.

Some airports may employ CT scans for baggage reinspection, in addition to standard X-ray scans. The increased X-ray exposure may affect photographic film. Therefore, it is recommended that you carry your photographic film with you into the cabin with your carry-on baggage.
